Green Office Certification Process


Steps to becoming certified:

- Step 1:** Fill out the Green Office certification calculator and send it to the Green Campus Program interns at csulbgreencampus@gmail.com
- Step 2:** The interns will award the office a level of Green Office Certification and provide suggestions to help the office achieve the highest level of certification
- Step 3:** The interns will check in with the office periodically to make sure sustainable practices are in place

Benefits of Being Certified

- Public recognition of being Green Office Certified
- Office will receive a certificate as well as visible signage to display once the office is certified
- Perks such as smartstrips will be provided to offices based on availability
 - By implementing more sustainable behaviors, money will be saved!
 - It will be easier for the office to become LEED certified in the future
- Your office will leave a smaller carbon footprint, helping the campus achieve a smaller greenhouse gas emission.
